

# **VISIONS DU RÉEL 2017 AWARD WINNERS**

# 7 years of magic and success: a review of Luciano Barisone's Artistic Direction, and the Sesterce d'or for a powerful film about the meaning of life in exile

28 April 2017, Nyon (Switzerland) – The consecration of the film *Taste of Cement*, a magisterial and moving testimony of life in exile for Syrian refugees in Lebanon, closes the 48th edition of Visions du Réel, Festival international de cinéma Nyon, this evening. This Closing Ceremony also marks the end of Luciano Barisone's term of office as the Festival's Artistic Director after seven years. "Seven is the magic or sacred number; seven is the symbolic number, often synonymous with perfection. Seven years is how long Luciano Barisone has been successfully directing the Festival, offering professionals, film fans and the general public a true lesson in film and humanity, which he was also able to share with colleagues and the Visions du Réel Foundation Board", highlights Claude Ruey, the Festival President. Visions du Réel has consolidated its success, with attendance figures reaching over 40,000 spectators. Many screenings were sold out–some, exceptionally, had to have additional screenings due to the enthusiasm of festivalgoers - particularly those for the Festival's Avant-Première and the opening and closing films.

#### The Sesterce d'or goes to Taste of Cement, by Ziad Kalthoum

With 130 world or international premieres, three Masterclasses with world-renowned guests—Alain Cavalier, Stéphane Breton, and Jacopo Quadri, the editor of all of Gianfranco Rosi's films—Visions du Réel confirms its role as a leading Festival in the field of documentary filmmaking, at an international level as well as for Switzerland. The quality of filmmaking for the 179 films from 55 countries has been applauded by juries and critics. Tonight, the Sesterce d'or La Mobilière for best feature film from the International Competition is awarded to Ziad Kalthoum for *Taste of Cement*, a film that bears witness to the daily life of Syrian construction workers building skyscrapers in Beirut, while their own houses are being shelled. The Jury awards this film for the power of its cinematographic language, and the way in which it emphasises the human capacity to create beauty - but also to destroy everything. Switzerland also takes pride of place with 6 films, including 3 co-productions. The Audience Prize goes to *In Loco Parentis*. The many opportunities for encounters—more than 1,200 film professionals, including 153 directors with a film on the programme, were present during the Festival—as well as the musical evenings of this 48th edition attracted an enthusiastic public to the Village du Réel.

#### Luciano Barisone's departure: seven years of magic and success

Luciano Barisone, Artistic Director, steps down this evening. As he had announced when Visions du Réel sought him out in Florence in 2010 to take over the direction of the Festival de Nyon, he led his final edition this year. He will therefore have successfully directed the Festival for seven years. "Throughout all this time, Luciano Barisone has constantly insisted on the high ethical and qualitative requirements that should preside over the selection of films. This teacher who became a festival director has indeed always been willing to meet others and in particular young people, whether they are at film school, secondary or high school; he is always passionate about encounters and sharing", recounts Claude Ruey, saluting the Artistic Director's commitment. Emilie Bujès, currently Luciano Barisone's Deputy and a member of the selection committee since 2012, has been nominated as his successor. She will take up her post in August in time to work on setting up the 49th edition of the Festival, which will take place from 13 to 21 April 2018.
