VdR-Industry creates dialogue between the Swiss and international industry

Visions du Réel reveals the first activities of its VdR-Industry programme, which is a major event for the Swiss and international industry. The professional component of the Festival, with its unique offering in Switzerland VdR-Film Market, also features various hybrid platforms for discussion concerning the Swiss industry. VdR-Industry is an ideal place for creating dialogue and stimulating debate between the Swiss and international branches, and for building lasting relationships and developing opportunities for concrete collaborations. Its accessibility and relaxed atmosphere make it stand out. Newly headed by Sophie Bourdon, it will take place in the heart of the Festival's 54th edition, from 23 to 27 April 2023 (details below).

Documentary & Audiovisual Forum

The Documentary & Audiovisual Forum, which will be held on Sunday 23 April at the opening of the Industry days, is primarily intended for Swiss professionals. A think tank and place for discussion for the national industry, the Forum invites the sector in all the country's linguistic regions to come together and exchange views in a setting that is conducive to reflection and the emergence of new ideas.

After focusing on the international distribution of Swiss documentaries last year, the Forum's 2023 edition will look at the issues related to audiences, particularly young audiences, and their relationships with broadcasting. VdR-Industry will propose a cross-disciplinary consideration of the match between films and audiences, the strategies to implement or develop to expand the spectrum of spectators, refreshing audiences, and the place that documentary film holds within this dynamic. It is a topical theme that will address professionals' current concerns.

Benelux is a fertile training ground for new talents accustomed to co-production.
