



## Eurimages Co-Production Prize & Eligibility

By participating to the VdR-Pitching showcase, you are potentially **eligible** for the **Eurimages Co-Production Development Prize**. This cash prize of **€20,000** has been created to promote the Eurimage Fund's role in encouraging international co-production from the initial stages of a project.

The criteria to be eligible for the Prize is as follows:

- projects must be at a development stage;
- projects must be of a minimum duration of 70 minutes intended for cinema release;
- projects must be conceived as co-productions from the early development stage for reasons other than simple co-financing;
- projects must be presented by one or more independent production companies from a Eurimages' member State, with the intention of involving at least one other production company from a different Eurimages' member State. Eurimages member States [are listed here](#) :  
Albania, Armenia, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Canada, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, North Macedonia, Montenegro, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovak Republic, Romania, Serbia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine.
- One or more companies from one or more non-member States may also join the project up to a maximum total participation of 30% in development financing;
- Projects must not have previously submitted to the Eurimages Co-production Support Programme.

If you adhere to the above criteria and would like to be considered for the prize, please submit the following information:

- A development financing plan demonstrating where the sources of development financing are coming from, which co-production country they are going to and the percentage each source represents in relation to the total development budget (the goal of this development finance plan is to demonstrate a Eurimages member state as the majority co-producer);
- A declaration by the applying producer that the project has not previously been submitted to the Eurimages Co-production Support Programme. The delegate (principal/majority) producer must submit a declaration on "exclusion criteria" to ensure eligibility. This must be completed by a legal representative of the delegate production company. Please follow [this link](#) to create an account and access the declaration platform.
